Participants also work on accuracy in order to enhance the effective use of language systems including grammar and vocabulary.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Ratio of 1 teacher to 4 students</p>

11:00-12:30	<p style="text-align: center;">Speaking with impact and clarity</p> <p>The focus is on expanding the use of the English language and vocabulary as well as enhancing pronunciation and diction skills in order to become a more influential speaker of English. Participants could be asked to select a topic of interest on which they prepare and deliver a presentation as well as to participate in debates and group discussions.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Ratio of 1 teacher to 4 students</p>

13:15 – 14:15	<p style="text-align: center;">Current Affairs</p> <p>Learners work on comprehension and expression skills by studying current affairs and media headlines analysed with a critical eye and compared to how other international media tackle issues from around the world.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Ratio of 1 teacher to 4 students</p>
14:20-15:20 Break 15:20-15:30 15:30-16:30	<p style="text-align: center;">Seminars</p> <p>Learners engage with topics such as “Prime Minister's Questions”, the life and works of CS Lewis and Lewis Carroll, the works and influence of the artist William Turner, Leadership and Management, British politics of the 1980s. These seminars are led by tutors who are passionate, engaged and knowledgeable in their chosen topic.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Ratio of 1 teacher to 8 students</p>
