PRACTICAL INFORMATION

When you arrive to Madrid airport you have 2 options to come to Segovia: By High Speed Train (AVE) – it takes around 25 minutes – Estación de Chamartín By bus . it takes around 1 hour – Bus station Madrid Moncloa




BUSES FROM TRAIN STATION TO SEGOVIA CITY CENTER

Leave the bus at the last stop (near the statue of Loba Capitolina) You will see the aqueduct. Go towards the aqueduct and you will see one wide pedestrian street called Avenida del Acueducto, on the right you will see the Tourist Information office and the street you musttake (C/ Juan Bravo). Follow that street, near the Casa de los Picos is the house with 3 rooms. For the other house continue walking and almost arriving to the main square will be the house of 4.

Take the Pink line (8) from any Terminal to Nuevos Ministerios


Change trains at Nuevos Ministerios to Grey Line (6) to Moncloa.

In the same station where the underground is there is the bus station. Look for the ticket window of the company AVANZA BUS (red and white) so you can buy the tickets. The bus usually is on the bay 8 or 9.

Get down on the last stop, the bus station, then leave the Station and across the street there is a pedestrian street (Avenida del Acueducto) follow it until the Aqueduct, and the look for the street on the right (Aqueduct on your back) close to the Tourism Office and that's the Juan Bravo Street where the houses are.
