The course in academic subjects allows them to develop knowledge on a specific subject such as history, geography or literature. **Exam preparation:** To take the exam in the best possible conditions. Weak points are analyzed by the teacher and class work is done to solve them. The teaching method is adapted to the preparation for the exam and to the needs of the student.

Activities & weekend: OISE offers a programme of activities during the week and on Saturdays to ensure that students make the most of their stay.





## The school experience

Lessons are taught in groups of no more than 8 students, creating a close-knit and supportive environment where students are able to create bonds with each other and their tutors.

Tutors offer personal academic support to each student during their time at the school, and tutors work closely with students to help them achieve their goals. Alongside classrooms there are breakout areas, self-study areas, and spaces for relaxation. Students and tutors spend lunch and break times together creating a welcoming and study focussed atmosphere.
